If a student earns an “F” in a core subject during any grading period, he or she can attend Grade Recovery. Students are removed from their PE or elective class to remediate the grade. During this time, students report to the Plato Lab to engage in interactive computer lessons to assist with the recovery process. A student’s grade may be raised as high as a “C” if the work meets the standard.</p>
